Palmer is owner, president and CEO of Palmer Physical Therapy for Women. Shank is an account executive with USI Midwest. Turner is retired from Spirit AeroSystems Inc. where he was chief executive.

Board members renewing for a second term, also effective July 1, 2015, are Pamela Clancy Ammar '80, Steve Feilmeier '85, treasurer, and Kent Richards '86. Clancy Ammar is a self-employed lawyer. Feilmeier is executive vice president and CFO for Koch Industries Inc. Richards is an audit supervisor for Informative Providers Inc.

The 19-member board is chaired by Marilyn Pauly '72, vice chair of Commerce Bank. Board members are eligible to serve two three-year terms.
