Far more students apply for financial aid each year than WSU has the resources to help. As Wichita State continues to prioritize accessibility and affordability, your support is needed now more than ever.

For scholarships awarded based on financial need, a simple formula is used to determine whether a student meets the criteria. If the student's Expected Family Contribution is less than the cost of attendance at Wichita State, then the student qualifies for need-based financial aid.

WSU is proud to support students achieve their dream of getting a college education, regardless of their financial standing. Need-based scholarships are essential to this mission.

NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP OPTIONS:

- 1 ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS: PERMANENT SUPPORT**
The minimum donation to endow a scholarship is \$50,000, which can be spread in equal payments over as many as five consecutive years.
- 2 CURRENT SCHOLARSHIPS: SUPPORT FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD**
The minimum to establish a current scholarship is \$5,000, which can be spread in equal payments over as many as five consecutive years.
